ALL Your Enemies Have Been Conquered!

Romans 8:31-39

Introduction...

- God's Word reminds us, encourages us, and strengthens us in knowing and believing by faith that IN CHRIST all of our enemies have been conquered!

- The final words of the 8th chapter of Romans form a sort of climax and we must first review the context before we can truly appreciate the climax.
 - Chapters 1-7

 - Beginning of chapter 8

Part I – Nothing Can Rob Us of His Forgiveness Vss. 31-34)

- Because God did not spare His own Son, we know that God is for us! (vs. 31-32)

- We know that God is for us and yet how often doesn't Satan or our own conscience level accusations against us?

- God answers these self inflicted accusations (vs. 33) Picture yourself in God's court room.

- And still we fear condemnation for our sins. But who can condemn us? God has the answer we can never hear enough. (vs. 34) Christ, our advocate has died for our sins and was raised and is reigning to prove it.

- Rejoice and revel and live in context of knowing that ALL your sins are forgiven by the One who loves you most.

Part II – Nothing Can Separate Us From His Love (Vss. 35-39)

- Can Satan and the things of this evil world separate us from the Love of God?

- God gives us an emphatic NO. (vs. 35-39)

- Don't fall into another of Satan's traps by forgetting those last important five words: "in Christ Jesus our Lord."

- Apart from Jesus there is nothing. With Jesus we have everything!

Conclusion/Review...

- In Christ means to have Jesus in you by faith and for you to be in Jesus through His word.

- IN CHRIST....ALL your enemies have been conquered and NOTHING can separate you from His love!
